Page 1: Story Comprehension: sequence of events in the story "If You Give a Mouse a Cookie" by Laura Numeroff. After reading the story, please color the pictures. Cut and paste the events in the order in which they occurred in the story.

Page 2: Handwriting: practice writing your first and last name 9 times. Only use capital letters on the first letter of your first name and last name. The rest of the letters must be written with lower case letters. Write neatly and leave finger space between your first and last name. Stay within the lines.

Pages 3 and 4: Letters: worksheets to practice proper letter formation. Trace the letters and then write the upper case and lowercase letters once on the lines.

Page 5: Numbers: a worksheet to practice proper number formation. Trace and write the numbers 1-10. Write the numbers 1-10 inside the boxes, in counting order.

We highly recommend that your child practice various skills over the summer, before entering kindergarten. Please practice the following with your child:

- Color recognition - red, blue, green, yellow, orange, purple, pink, brown, gray, white, black
- Shape recognition - square, rectangle, triangle, circle, rhombus, pentagon, hexagon
- Color words - red, blue, green, yellow, orange, purple, pink, brown, gray, white, black
- Number words - zero, one, two, three, four, five, six, seven, eight, nine, ten
